**RE : HUDUMANAMBA REGISTRATION IN CHUBU REGION**

The Government of Kenya embarked on a National Integrated Identity Management System (NIIMS) exercise locally referred to as “Hudumanamba registration” aimed at creating a central master population database for all Kenyan citizens including those abroad. The exercise was launched at the Kenya Embassy Chancery on 13<sup>th</sup> May 2019 and has been on-going since then. The Mass registration deadline is on **20<sup>th</sup> June 2019**.

In view of this deadline, Kenya Embassy has decided to roll out registration of Kenyans beyond the Embassy Chancery. In this regard, the Kenya Embassy hereby announce to all Kenyans of Chubu Region that there will be Hudumanamba Registration on **Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> (10.00 am - 3.00 pm) June 2019** at **Toyota Tsusho Nagoya Head Office, Meeting Room “Kiteo”, 2nd Floor, Century Toyota Bldg, 9-8, Meieki 4-chome, Nakamura-ku, Nagoya 450-8575.** ([Click for access map to the meeting room](#)) All Kenyans of this region are therefore requested to register online and avail themselves within the specified time for final registration. Please, note that the kits are configured to register people using the reference and document number which you will get after completing online registration. It is highly recommended that you turn up early between 10.00 am to 1.00 pm for registration since at this time the system is fast.

To register open the <https://diaspora.hudumanamba.go.ke/diaspora> click Register now; then on create new account; enter your name and email address; then click on create; you will receive a password on your email; login using this password and complete the online form; click submit and save. You will receive an email with the reference and document number; carry these numbers along with the

original registration document – Kenyan ID/Passport for those above 18years and birth certificate/Passport for those below 18 years. Children under 6 years will not be taken biometrics but make sure to register them through the same process and carry their original documents.
